POINTS FOR PRAYER

MIDDLE EAST

It is believed almost 2,000 people, have been killed during the past four weeks in Gaza and Israel, the majority of who are believed to be Palestinian civilians. At the time of writing, a ceasefire is in place and indirect talks between both sides are taking place.

Last Friday (1st), the Moderator, Rt Rev. Dr. Michael Barry issued a statement saying that, *"...Christians are called to be peacemakers and to encourage peacemakers in conflict situations.... we condemn the senseless killing in the Middle East and urge those involved to call a permanent ceasefire and work for a better shared future.... I would call on Christians on this island [Ireland] to pray earnestly for peace both here and in the Middle East...."*

- Pray for all those suffering as a result of the ongoing conflicts in the Middle East. Remember especially those who are mourning and those who have fled their homes due to the conflicts.
- Pray that sufficient humanitarian assistance and medical help will reach all in need.
- Pray for all efforts to bring a ceasefire and a peaceful and just end to each conflict.

IRAQ

Every Mosul church destroyed or occupied

Just three years ago Open Doors estimated that there were 7,500 Christians in Mosul. Today that number stands at zero. All 45 church buildings, some of which have stood for hundreds of years, have been boarded up, destroyed, occupied, converted into mosques or made into ISIS headquarters:

Half a million people, including up to 3,000 Christian families, have now fled Mosul for northern Iraqi cities like Erbil to escape ISIS extremist forces and are now without shelter or possessions. An increase in violence and threats have left many traumatised and fearful for their own lives.

Please pray for the protection and care of the vulnerable and for Christian organisations that endeavour to bring God's hope to these broken Christian families and many others who have fled their homes.
